**Guidelines for Online Registration - Admission 2021 -2022**

In order to ensure uniformity and to regulate the admission procedure in Sikkim Government College, Education Department (Directorate of Higher Education) following guidelines are hereby notified

- I. Registration of Candidates in Sikkim Government College(s) shall be done centrally through Online Mode. The Candidates can log in to [www.sgcregistration.com](http://www.sgcregistration.com) or through RUSA SIKKIM ADMISSION Mobile Application which can be downloaded from Android Platform.

II. **INTAKE CAPACITY:**

- a. Following shall be college wise Intake Capacity for the Academic Session 2021 – 22.
- b. For B.Ed College, Soreng the Admission Dates and Intake Capacity shall be updated in [www.sgcregistration.com](http://www.sgcregistration.com) at the time of admission.

1. The Admission to all the Government Colleges will be given as per the intake capacity mentioned above.
2. A central online committee at the Directorate of Higher Education, including representative from respective colleges will be constituted for monitoring, supervision and addressing the discrepancies if any during the admission process.
3. Merit List will be based on the policy of best of 4 subjects in case of ISC and best of 5 in case of CBSE, and other State Boards. Based on the eligibility rule table (Annexure I) the marks obtained in the subject for which the candidate has applied will mandatorily be a part of best of 4 or best of 5 subjects for calculating the merit of the candidate.

**Note:** Sikkim government Law College, Burtuk will consider only those candidates who have passed five subjects compulsory either in CBSE, ISC and other state board.

4. Candidates other than Certificate of Identification or Sikkim Subject or Residential Certificate must have at least 70% Cumulative mark to be eligible for merit list but if the candidates score is less than 70%, they will be directly called for counseling.

**Note:** For counseling the candidate must have filled online registration form.

5. Candidate who are not list out in 1st and 2nd merit list they will be called for counseling but the admission will purely based on the vacant seats followed by category wise reservation and merit.

**6. Category wise Reservation on Intake Capacity:**

- a. The 85% of the Intake Capacity of all the Government Colleges will be reserved for Certificate of Identification or Sikkim Subject Holders.
- b. 10% of the Intake Capacity will be allotted to Residential Certificate Holders. Only the certificates issued in pursuance of Home Department Notification No: 23/Home/2015 dated 15/05/2015 will be considered valid.
- c. 5% intake capacity will be allotted to wards of Regular State Government Employees (Non-Local); Central Government Employees, Army Personal, CPMF (Central Paramilitary force) transferred or working in Sikkim at the time of admission of their ward, candidate who have studied in Sikkim Government School, Sports Quota (National level) and candidate belonging to outside the state.
- d. For Differently Able Candidate 5% of the total intake capacity of each program of all the college will be reserved for the allotment of seat on the basis of merit list generated.

**Note:** If the seats in any of the category remain vacant it would be accordingly allotted to the candidate having Certificate of Identification, Sikkim Subject and Residential Certificate Holder. Further, if the seats are still vacant it would then be considered to Regular State Government Employees (Non-Local); Central Government Employees, Army Personal, CPMF (Central para Military Forces) transferred or working in Sikkim, and candidate who have studied in Sikkim Government School and candidate belonging to outside the state, sport Quota (National Level) at the time of admission of their wards on the basis of merit.

7. A Candidate can opt for either three colleges with one course per college or one college with three courses, or three colleges with three courses provided they are eligible to opt for the course and college (Refer Annex I).
8. The Candidates who have studied Science in their 10 + 2 can apply for B.Sc., B.A., B. Com or B. Voc based on the eligibility rule table (Refer Annexure I).
9. The Candidates who have studied Humanities in their 10 + 2 can apply for B.A. or B. Voc based on the eligibility rule table (Refer Annexure I).
10. The Candidates who have studied Commerce in their 10 + 2 can apply for B. Com, B.A. or B. Voc based on the eligibility rule table (Refer Annexure I).
11. The Candidates who have studied Vocational in their 10 + 2 can apply for B. Voc, B. Com, B.A. or B.Sc. (Computer Science) based on the eligibility rule table (Refer Annexure I).
12. Seat allocation is completely based on Marks Percentage (Cumulative marks) and course. Merit List will be generated as per the marks percentage scored by the candidate followed by course which they have applied.

13. Compartmental Candidates of academic year 2021-22 are not eligible to apply. However, candidates who cleared the improvement exams prior to admission for 2021 can apply.
14. The candidate whose name is listed out in various colleges in merit list, he/she will be eligible for admission to only one college and with his/her choice of course.
15. Candidates who will pay the prospectus fee through Demand Draft must upload the scan copy of the Demand Draft at the time of registration and submit the same during the time of Admission.
16. **Calculation for Cumulative percentage:**

Cumulative percentage of the candidate will be calculated as follows:

- I. Aggregate percentage of a candidate best of (5 for CBSE and Best of 4 for ISC) will be taken as Component A
- II. Aggregate percentage of his/her marks in the applied subject and average of the remaining best of 4 for CBSE and 3 for ISC will be taken as Component B

Therefore, cumulative Percentage will be  $(A+B)/2$ , this will be the base for deciding the percentage

- Candidates who feature in the merit list (General Degree College) has an option to join only one College with one course within the merit list
- A candidate who joins as per the merit list will be out of the subsequent merit list.
- If the candidate chooses not to join the college/course where his/her name featured in the merit list, the candidate will be again eligible for subsequent merit list generation process other than the one where the candidate applied but did not feature in the merit list.
- The candidates who do not join the college within the stipulated time, their seat will be forfeited.
- The candidate whose name appears in the merit list (Law College, LLB) can opt for the course and the candidate will be eligible for 2<sup>nd</sup> merit list generation process for other degree courses they have applied provided the candidate whose name is not featured in any degree course in 1<sup>st</sup> Merit List. Then after, the candidate has to choose only one college with one course.
- The candidate whose name appears in the merit list (General Degree courses) can opt for the course and the candidate will be eligible for 2<sup>nd</sup> merit list generation process for only Law College provided the candidate's name was not featured in Law College in the 1<sup>st</sup> Merit List, and then after, the candidate has to choose only one college with one course.

## GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION 2021

### A. SEAT RESERVATION POLICY

- a) The totals of 90% seat are reserved for COI holders of Sikkim and 10% to Non-COI category.
- b) One seat each in the lateral entry may be allocated to the Non-COI category candidates.
- c) 5% reservation of total sanctioned seat (supernumerary) to PWD (person with disabilities) category (as per AICTE guideline).

### C. FEE PAYMENT POLICY

- a) COI holder candidate will be imparted free education as per the policy of the Govt.
- b) Candidate having Mother's COI, Resident Certificate (RC) & Service certificate will be considered as OTHERS category and 25% rebate on tuition fees will be given.
- c) Non-COI candidates from within & outside state will pay the nominal prescribed fees approved by BOG.

Madam,

With respect to the subject mentioned above, B.Sc(Microbiology) is to be introduced in our college from session 2021-22 vide Ref.No. 19/DIR/HE/HRDD dated 06/08/21. In view of this college has been asked to give information regarding minimum eligibility criterion and elective combination for B.Sc(Microbiology). It may be noted here that Sikkim University is the authority for determining eligibility criterion. However, B.Sc (Hons.) courses in Botany and Zoology are running in our college and the minimum eligibility criterion is 10+2 in science and must have passed in Biology. In view of this the eligibility criterion and elective combinations may be kept as follows:
